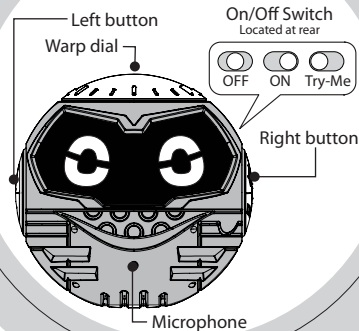
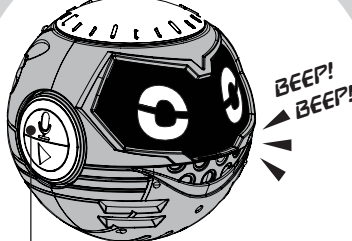


## YOUR YAKBOT

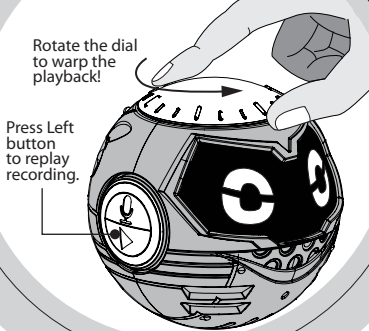


## RECORDING



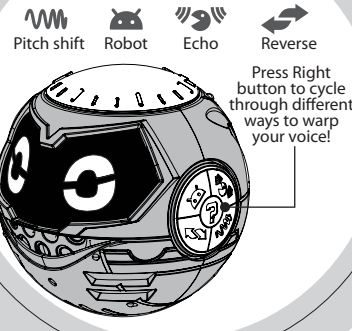
Hold down Left button for 2 seconds or more then let go. Record your voice after the beeping tone. NOTE: Talk towards the microphone.

## PLAYBACK



Press Left button to replay recording.

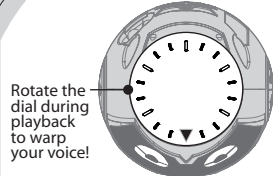
## VOICE FILTERS



Pitch shift Robot Echo Reverse

Press Right button to cycle through different ways to warp your voice!

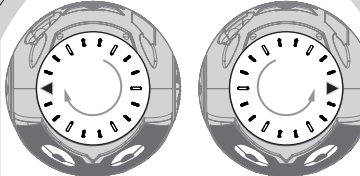
## WARP DIAL



Rotate the dial during playback to warp your voice!

**Centre position**  
• Pitch shift - Normal voice  
• Robot - Half robot  
• Echo - Half echo  
• Reverse - Normal voice

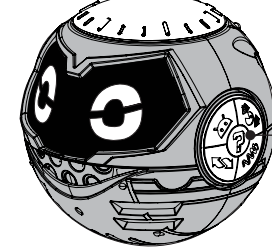
## WARP DIAL



**Left position**  
• Pitch shift - Helium voice  
• Robot - Full robot  
• Echo - Full echo  
• Reverse - Helium voice

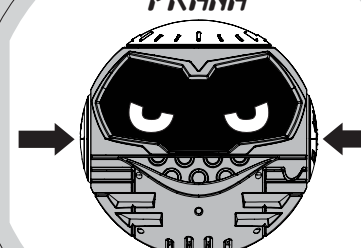
**Right position**  
• Pitch shift - Monster voice  
• Robot - Normal voice  
• Echo - Light echo  
• Reverse - Monster voice

## ANSWER MAN



Hold down Right button for 2 seconds. After the prompt, ask Yakbot a Yes/No question and prepare for some awesome advise!

## TIME BLAST PRANK



Hold down both buttons for 3 seconds to trigger the secret "time blast prank" mode.

## TIME BLAST PRANK



Roll Yakbot towards your friends during the count down and prepare for a surprise reaction from them!

## TROUBLESHOOTING

**Yakbot's function does not match instructions.**  
• Always ensure switch is in 'ON' or 'OFF' position, not 'TRY ME'.

**Yakbot does not answer my questions properly.**  
• Try to speak closer and louder to the microphone when asking your questions.  
• Yakbot may not always know the answer to your questions, he may say something irrelevant to avoid embarrassment!

**I want to delete a recorded message.**  
• To erase a previously recorded message, press and hold the Left button to record a new one.  
• Alternatively flick switch to 'TRY ME' position then back to 'ON'.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

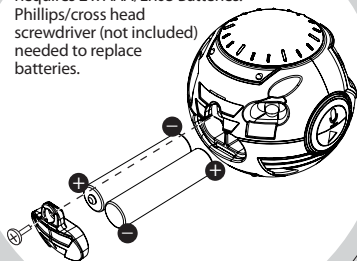
**Yakbot does not repeat my entire message.**  
• When 'ON' the Yakbot will record up to 10 seconds of sound.

• Ensure to only start speaking after the 'beep' tone.  
• Ensure there are no significant pauses in what you say. Yakbot will think this is the end of your message and begin playback.  
• Try to speak closer to the microphone when recording.

• Make sure you are in a quiet area with no loud background noise and you are holding Yakbot close to your mouth.

## BATTERIES

Requires 2 x AAA/LR03 Batteries. Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.



## BATTERIES

- Use new batteries to obtain best performance.
- Alkaline batteries recommended.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries should be replaced by an adult.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.

## BATTERIES

- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from product.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Batteries are to be removed from the product before long term storage.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

**IMPORTANT NOTE ON BATTERY REPLACEMENT**  
If Yakbot's sounds or buttons do not function properly DO NOT RETURN TO THE STORE. Replace with fresh batteries as shown.
